Special Educational Needs & Inclusion Statement

Saint Peter's Catholic Primary School follows the local authority principles for inclusion. These principles are underpinned by a National Framework of Statutory Laws and Guidance, including the Disability Discrimination Act and the Special Educational Needs and Disability Act.

"Inclusive educational communities are those which take account of the needs of individuals and where individuals are valued, feel secure and have a sense of belonging."

Pupils with special educational needs and/or disabilities must have their needs met in line with the SEND Code of Practice.

Saint Peter's seeks to enable pupils who have special educational needs to be included successfully within mainstream education. This means that we have a clear responsibility to make reasonable adjustments to accommodate the needs of pupils with special educational needs and disabilities.

Saint Peter's sets high expectations for all learners. For children with special educational needs and/or disabilities an SEN Support Plan is created through discussion with teachers, parents, carers and the children themselves. Teachers plan learning opportunities that enable children to develop positive relationships and actively seek to remove barriers to learning and participation. Opportunities are provided for support in class and for additional teaching of literacy and mathematics.

Teachers take specific action by:

- providing for pupils who may need help with communication, language and literacy
 - planning for pupils' full participation in learning and in physical and practical activities
 - helping pupils to manage their behaviour
 - helping individuals to manage their emotions, particularly trauma or stress
